Early Years Foundation Stage

60% of pupils reached a **good level of development**.

Nationally 66% achieved this standard in **2016**

Children are defined as having a **good level of development** at the end of EYFS if they have been assessed as achieving at the expected standard in:

- The *prime* areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development and communication and language) **AND**
- The *specific* areas of learning (maths and literacy)

Phonics

68% reached the expected standard in the phonics screening check.

Nationally 81% achieved the standard.

End of Key Stage 1 (Year 2)
