RECEPTION CHILDREN CURRICULUM PLAN TERM 3 2018

Winter and Dinosaurs

We plan most of our learning around books. This term our main texts will be:

“Harry and the Dinosaurs” series

“Dinosaur Roar”

Daisy Dinosaur Gets Lost”

“Little Rex and the Big Roar”

“Tom and the Island of Dinosaurs”

Literacy/Communication and Language

The children will learn to recognise and write digraphs (sounds made by two letters)
We will send home the letters we have been learning every week for you to practise.

We will practise blending sounds to read and segmenting words to spell.

WE will learn to read some more tricky words.

The children will be encouraged to write independently – Children will be taught to write the sounds they can hear in words to have plausible attempts at spelling.

Numeracy

The children will; be learning to add and take away with numbers up to 10.

They will learn to say 1 more and 1 less than any number to 20.

Encourage - Enjoy - Excel



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We will be doing lots of counting – forwards, backwards and from different starting points.

The children will learn the name of some 3D shapes and will continue to learn about money and time.

Physical Development

Fine motor skills: We will focus on forming all letters with the correct formation. This is really important for later on in school when the children learn to join letters together.

Gross motor skills: There are many opportunities every day in the garden for children to develop their balancing, running and jumping skills.

In addition to this they will have a weekly PE session which will focus on specific skills.

Some children will have the opportunity this term to learn to ride a balance bike. Over the course of the school year all children will get the opportunity and by the end of the year we hope that most children will be able to ride a pedal bike.

Health and Self care: The children will learn about the importance of hand washing. We will also talk about foods which are healthy and foods which should just be for a treat.

Personal/Social and Emotional Development

We are going to focus on “feelings” – how to recognise feelings in ourselves and others. We will talk about the consequences of our behaviour.

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Creative Development

Our creative activities will link to our topics and the children will enjoy using a range of media to create art work.

Understanding the World

The children will learn about the natural world through exploring the garden and by visiting the forest each week.

There will be opportunities for baking to learn about how things change when mixed and cooked.

The children will learn about the changes that take place from Winter through to Spring. They will also learn about how to keep safe on dark nights.

We will put information on Tapestry every week about what we are learning so that you are able to support your child.
