Dear parents/carers

Our residential visit to Conover Hall is now less than 8 weeks away. We would like to give you an update as to what we will be doing, and what kit you will need to pack to be prepared for our visit.

On the Monday 12th March, you should bring all luggage to school at the normal time. We will be setting off around 10:00, but please arrive on time so we can make sure everyone has everything needed.

On our way to Conover Hall, we shall be stopping for lunch at Telford town park, so please send your child with a packed lunch (No fizzy drinks and sweets please). We will stay at the park for around an hour, and then continue to Conover hall, arriving at around 14:00.

When we arrive, we will be given a short tour and then time to settle into our bedrooms, which usually have between 8 and 12 beds. After this, our activities will start. All food will be provided, so again please do not send your child with fizzy drinks or sweets. Your child may bring a camera and up to £10 spending money for the gift shop. However, we will not allow your child to bring toys, mobile phones, tablets or any other devices. They can however, bring a book to read. We will aim to keep you up to date using ClassDojo throughout the trip.

After leaving Conover Hall, we will be coming straight home, so should be back at school for around our normal home time (we will send a text on the day to confirm this)

Please find an equipment list overleaf but please note that swimming and disco clothes will only be required if we are doing these activities – we will let you know nearer the time.
